Hearing Dogs for the Deaf

Hearing Dogs for the Deaf train carefully selected dogs to alert severely, profoundly or totally deaf people to the everyday sounds which hearing people may take for granted : alarm clock, doorbell, telephone, smoke alarm, baby alarm, cooker timer.

By responding to these sounds, the dogs communicate by touch and then lead to the sound source, providing a deaf person with greater independence and confidence , more awareness of their environment as well as the blessing of companionship and feeling of security.

The scheme has been in operation since 1982, its work funded entirely through voluntary contributions.
